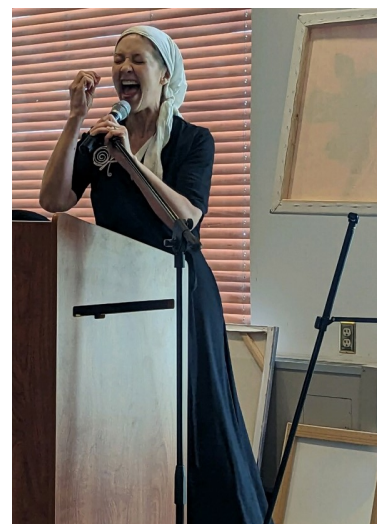
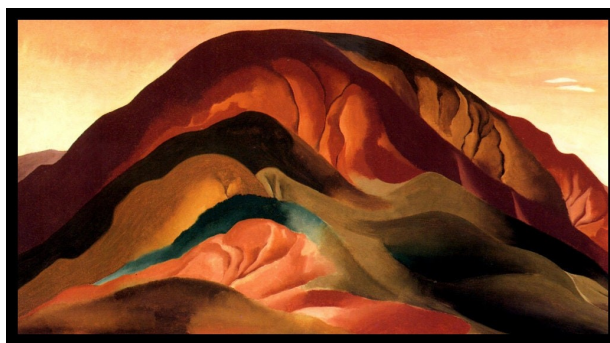
President's Letter

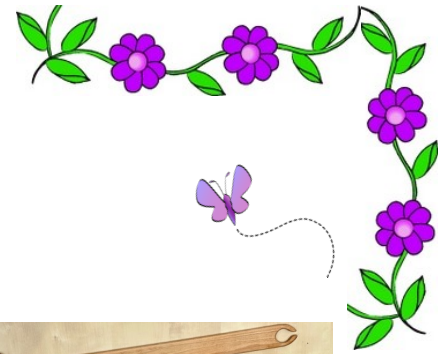
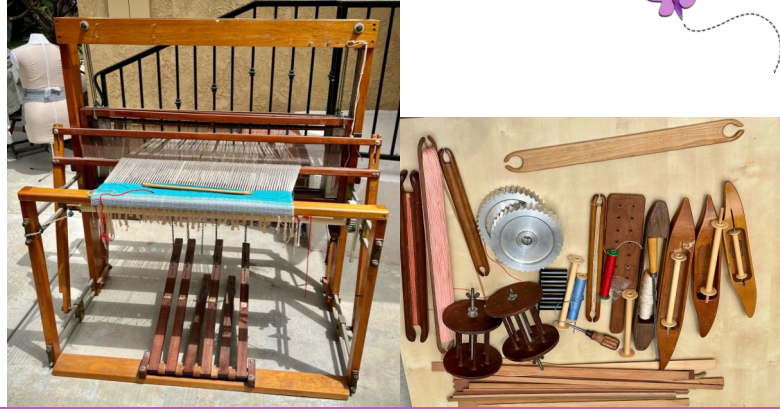
