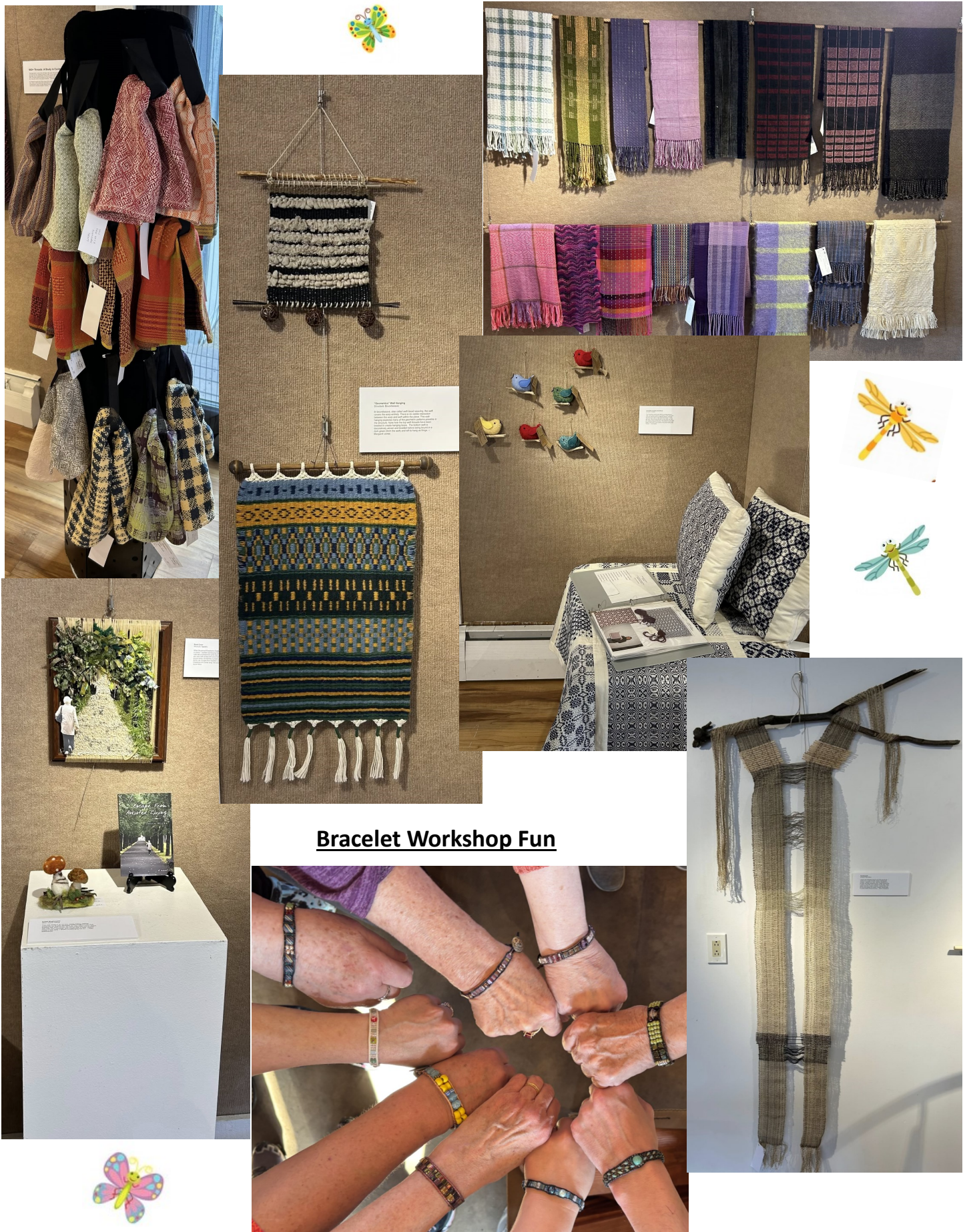


### Exhibit Announcement

A textile exhibit this summer at the Gardner Center gallery in Miller Beach is being curated by guild member Jane Whedbee. Titled "Through the Needle's Eye", the show is centered around work done using the needle - the most fundamental, primitive, and necessary textile tool, and one of the earliest tools made by mankind. The needle and its work are common to most homes (even non-sewers can usually sew a button back on, and most people have some kind of experience of family or friends who do creative or useful needlework). It is therefore familiar, and accessible, but we aim to expand that familiarity, enlarge the possibilities, and in presenting a range of diverse work offer everyone who sees the show something that surprises and engages them. Nine nationally established and regional artists will present work in applique, quilting, and embroidery to produce both abstract and representative significant art. The opening is July 25, and the show continues through August 29.

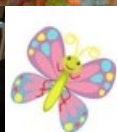
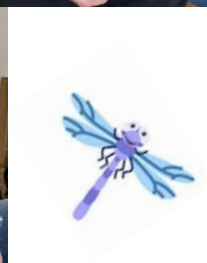
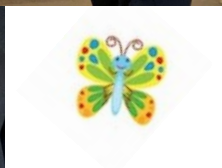
