Warp/Plied Bobbins Count:

I'm sitting at the loom. I have been trying to weave the cotton warp I dyed at our October workshop with Amanda Baxter. I have changed the pattern three times. Because I only have so much of the weft to match, I have taken it out or unwoven it twice.

My original idea was to weave a window in double weave. I wove about 12 inches when I realized the pattern wasn't working. The window frame, which should have been solid color, wasn't. This is a weave structure I want to master but not on this warp.

Next up was a twill. I wove through the pattern a few times. This particular pattern is to weft-faced. This means that the cotton I am weaving with is covering too much of the warp. That defeats the whole purpose of having a painted warp. Stay tuned and hopefully I will have something finished by our November meeting.

Speaking of our November meeting, I am looking forward to seeing everyone as we learn some tricks and tips. Don't forget that Interwoven Expressions starts at 9:00 am at Sand Creek Country Club. Some of our members will be participating. It is always fun to see what other people are doing. The holidays are approaching, you might find a gift for that one person who's always hard to buy for.
